2021 marked GFJ's 106th year of service to the Greater Endicott community. Again, the library went through some trying times due to the ongoing pandemic. We have worked to safely continue increasing our hours and services. I'm hopeful that we will keep adapting and serving our patrons in the best ways possible.

In 2021, we remained dedicated to fulfilling our library's mission to the GFJ community. We re-crafted our mission statement to better reflect our service goals and the community that we serve. The library staff has presented successful programs to the community with virtual, hybrid, and in-person offerings. This has included Tech Center classes and individual tech assistance, story times, book clubs for all ages, take & make activities, and more. We now offer a self-checkout station in the library, and continue to offer our curbside pickup service. We were again an early polling location in 2021 and were pleased to have many Broome County residents vote at the library.

We have already completed a major capital improvement project this year. Recently, we renovated our downstairs meeting room (Scott Room). The renovation included a new lighting system, carpet, a closet, and a HVAC unit. We also installed a new ADA-compliant bathroom. These projects were made possible due to NYS library construction grant funds. I thank our local legislators, Assemblymember Donna Lupardo and Senator Fred Akshar, for working diligently to procure this funding. Recently, we also installed a new ADAcompliant circulation desk. The desk was paid for with a Community Foundation Grant and a generous patron donation. We are happy to have a circulation desk that will meet the needs of our staff and all library patrons.

We thank you all for your support and your patience throughout these projects and over the years. We truly appreciate our patrons and look forward to seeing you in the library soon!
